Hannah G. Solomon found her own calling when she was asked to convene a Jewish Women’s Congress for the Chicago World’s Fair. Gathering the most preeminent Jewish women from across the country took Hannah several years and nearly 2,000 handwritten letters. This Congress became the national Council of Jewish Women. And so it began, and continues to today – the fight for the right to fair paying jobs, education, voting rights, health care, equal rights and economic well being for the less fortunate.

Rachel Women Helping Children \$25,000
Rachel Kauffman began the Los Angeles section of NCJW in 1909, inspired by Hannah G. Solomon’s example. Early efforts included aid to new immigrants and ensuring that underprivileged children received nutritious school lunches. 100 years later, NCJW/LA programs provide opportunities for children to learn through art, experience new cultures, and love libraries and reading. Rachel Kauffman’s legacy, like that of Jacob’s wife Rachel, centers on the welfare of children.
